

REGULATIONS ON THE OLYMPIAD
in the discipline "Clinical pharmacology"
for 4th year students of the Faculty of Pharmacy
for 2024/2025 academic year

1. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE OLYMPIAD:

- 1.1. Engaging students to acquire deeper and more solid knowledge of the discipline.
- 1.2. Formation of a creative and proactive approach to solving tasks.
- 1.3. Development of students ' cognitive activity and independent work skills.
- 1.4. Involvement of students in research work at the department.
- 1.5. Providing an opportunity to test your knowledge in a particular scientific field in a competitive environment.

2. GENERAL PROVISIONS OF THE OLYMPIAD.

Students of the 4th year of the Faculty of Pharmacy who do not have current twos, absences of practical classes and lectures for a disrespectful reason in the discipline "Clinical Pharmacology" are invited to participate in the Olympiad. The number of participants must be at least 10.

3. TIME OF THE OLYMPIAD: June 2025

4. STAGES OF THE OLYMPIAD:

- 4.1. **The first round** – selection of participants of the Olympiad, taking into account the rating system provided at the department, the regularity of attending lectures and the personal desire of students;
- 4.2. **The second round** consists of two tasks: a) **a crossword** consisting of 23 questions for a comprehensive assessment of knowledge on the main theoretical issues of clinical pharmacology. The maximum number of points for this section is 23 points.
b) **situational task** on practical skills of pharmacotherapy of basic nosological diseases. The maximum number of points is 5.

5. SUMMING UP THE RESULTS.

When summing up the results, the time of completing tasks and the total number of points are taken into account, it is carried out by teachers participating in the organization and conduct of the Olympiad.

Students who have taken 1-3 places and won prizes based on the results of participation in the Olympiad are exempt from admission pre-examination testing and receive additional bonus points, which are combined with the points for the current and

intermediate certification and are taken into account when setting the final score for the exam on the established scale:

- for 1st place – 5 points
- for the 2nd place – 3 points
- for the 3rd place – 2 points.
